



## **7. General Business**

- 7.1 IGA Donation – C Brockwell from Wagin IGA has funds to donate to a community group in Wagin and he has approached P&C with a donation of \$500. Discussion was held and it was decided to spend the funds on sporting equipment for students to use during break times, with the possibly (cost dependent) on replacing the basketball backboards. C Painter to research the cost of the backboards. N Ward to contact C Brockwell to provide feedback.
- 7.2 End of Year events – These functions were discussed in the Principal's Report. Two functions will be held to conclude the school year. An end of year concert on Thursday 12th December in the evening, with each class performing an item. - 7.6 2020 executive and committee positions - N Ward asked members to give some consideration to taking on a committee role in 2020. All positions will be declared vacant and we will be seeking nominations for members to take on positions.
- 7.7 Staff Christmas Function – J Mangalavite asked if P&C would be interested in catering for this function on Thursday 19<sup>th</sup> December. Event will be held at the bowling club. C Painter to confirm with J Mangalavite once further discussions are held.
