We will soon be conducting an election to elect two School Council members in the parent category. All parents and carers of students are eligible to vote.

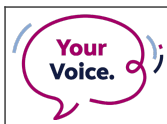

## Tell Them From Me

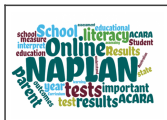
This week we are inviting students, teachers and parents to provide feedback on their experience of our school using an online survey. The surveys are an important part of our whole school evaluation and planning process.

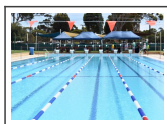
